

Regulations



1. ANNOUNCEMENT

Coltness Car Club Ltd. will promote the Coltness 200 on Saturday 1 October 2016. The event will Start and Finish at Dalsersf Bowling Club, Ashgillhead Road, Ashgill, Larkhall, ML9 3AF. Further instructions will be issued with the Final Instructions, and at Documentation.

2. JURISDICTION

Held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) as a Touring Assembly, these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event. An MSA Touring Assembly Permit has been requested and will be advised when issued.

A Certificate of Exemption, Touring Assembly/Procession Permit numbered 96870 has been issued by the MSA for the event.

3. ELIGIBILITY

The event is open to all members of Coltness Car Club Ltd. and to members of invited Car Clubs within Scottish Association of Car Clubs.

4. VEHICLES

The event is open to all classic motor vehicles manufactured prior to 1975, however vehicles of any age, or which are of particular interest, shall be allowed to take part. All cars must be legal for use on the public highway.

All vehicles must have valid road fund licence, and if required, a current MOT certificate. Cars must comply with the MSA Regulations for the event. All tyres used must be road legal. A warning triangle must be carried.

5. ROUTE, NAVIGATION AND DRIVING BEHAVIOUR

The route will cover approximately 200 miles on public A and B class roads and unclassified roads. The route will be on sealed surfaces, however you should note that some of the roads are narrow and uneven and care should be exercised, particularly with wide or low slung vehicles.

The route will be defined by a Route Book which will be provided at Documentation. Participants must comply with the Road Traffic Act **and drive in a responsible and considerate manner**. Racing or pace making will not be tolerated. Failure to comply may result in exclusion from the event. Further details will be published in the Final Instructions.

6. ENTRY LIST AND ENTRIES

The entry list opens on publication of these Regulations and Entry Form. All entries must be made on the Entry Form and be accompanied by the appropriate fee. Verbal entries will not be accepted. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. Entries will close at 18:00 on Saturday 24 September 2016.

The entry fee is £40.00 for a crew of 2 which includes Identification Plates, Route and Points of Interest Books and Starter Certificate. Additional crew members can be added at a fee of £10.00 per person.

Refreshments and snacks will be available at the Halfway Halt. A buffet will be provided at the Finish. Start time for buffet at the Finish of the tour, and further details will be in the Final Instructions.

7. INSURANCE

Participants are responsible for ensuring that all drivers and vehicles entered in the event are fully covered by insurance during the event as required by the Road Traffic Act and will be required to sign a declaration to that effect at Documentation.

A minimum of Third Party Insurance for all persons who will drive participating vehicles must be applicable for the duration of the event. All crew members will also be required to sign a declaration at the start on the signing-on sheet indemnifying the organisers and the Motor Sports Association from any liability.

8. SCRUTINEERING, DOCUMENTATION AND START

Pre event Scrutiny, Documentation and Signing on will take place at Dalserf Bowling Club, Ashgillhead Road, Ashgill, Larkhall, ML9 3AF between 08:00 and 09:00 on Saturday 1 October 2016. The first car is expected to depart the venue at 09:30.

9. DATA PROTECTION ACT

Information supplied on the Entry Form will be held on computer and used for event administration.

FURTHER INFORMATION – EVENT OVERVIEW

A Classic Road Tour covering approx. 200 miles. The Tour Starts and finishes at Dalserf Bowling Club, Ashgillhead Road, Ashgill, Larkhall, ML9 3AF and travels on A and B class roads and unclassified roads in South Lanarkshire, Dumfries and Galloway, Scottish Borders and Mid Lothian.

Cars will be set off at approximately one minute intervals in number order to keep a good distance between participants. With no further timing implementation, the day will include a procession of cars touring central Scotland. A road book and points of interest book will be issued to participants. To make the day more interesting, some problem solving may be encountered.

After approx. 100 miles, there will be a Halfway Halt where food will be available and there will be a buffet provided by the organisers at the Finish venue. This will have a specific start time to allow fellow participants to finish the event and enjoy the social element of the Tour.

This event will be open initially to members of Coltness Car Club members and members of invited clubs who can participate in classic cars. Should levels of classic cars be low, entries will be offered to prospective participants with interesting road cars.
